

Metric helps Exigen transform a Docklands Warehouse

Exigen Group is a UK-owned insolvency practice based in London that provides business turnaround, restructuring, and property solutions. They offer services to businesses facing financial challenges, including turnaround and restructuring, liquidation, and cash flow finance. The Challenge

One of the main challenges we faced transforming the warehouse into a fully functional office was reimagining an industrial shell into a space that felt inviting, efficient, and inspiring. Balancing open-plan flexibility with areas for focused work meant optimising every square foot - without losing the building's raw character and beauty.

To transform the warehouse into a high-performing office, we undertook a full interior fit-out that balanced functionality with a warm, contemporary feel. Bench desk runs were introduced to maximise the collaborative workspace while preserving clean lines of sight and flexibility. We created a welcoming breakout kitchen area at the heart of the space - offering staff a place to recharge, connect, and gather informally. Enclosed meeting rooms were constructed with acoustic consideration, using glass as much as possible to allow natural light to flow through while supporting the need for privacy. Our interior designer chose furniture with subtle textures and tonal contrasts, the onceindustrial shell now supports both productivity and well-being.









The refurbishment of the warehouse represented a complete transformation from raw shell to a cohesive, contemporary office space. The project began with a full internal strip-out, enabling the introduction of a new suspended ceiling with integrated LED lighting to deliver uniform brightness and improve energy efficiency. Throughout the space, durable, high-spec flooring was laid to define a clear and consistent flow between working zones.

A mix of glazed and traditional partitioning was installed to create meeting rooms and offices that retained a sense of openness and visual connectivity. A newly constructed breakout kitchen formed the social heart of the workspace, complete with integrated appliances and robust finishes designed for daily use. The reception area was comprehensively reimagined to provide a professional and welcoming first impression, aligning with the aesthetic feel of the interior and functional aspirations of the overall design. The result is a workspace that balances performance with personality rooted in purpose, yet ready to adapt as the organisation evolves.








